Welcome to Kita-Aobayama Library!



Kita-Aobayama Library holds approximately 400,000 volumes of materials in the fields of science and pharmacy. **The library is closed for renovation and reopening on 1st Nov.** Before reopening, some of our services are available at the temporary library. This leaflet provides you some tips for your study and research.

1. Using the temporary library

- ◆Location: Aobayama-Kita Campus H-26 Physics A Bldg. 4F (Room 417)
- ♦ Opening Hours: Weekdays 9:00-17:00 (Closed on Saturdays, Sundays, holidays)
- •Entering: Please register your affiliation etc. via the 2D code at the entrance when entering the room for statistics.
- Materials in the temporary library: Newly arrived books, magazines and newspapers. (OPAC Location: KITALIB-Temporary)
- Available Services:
 - -Borrowing (Newly arrived books) *Your library card is necessary.
 - -Returning *The book drop on the 1^{st} floor is open for 24 hours.
 - -Receiving (Requested books and materials from other universities)
 - -Reference service
- Borrowing allowances:
 - Undergraduate students: 5 books
 - Graduate students and faculty members: 10 books
 - *KITALIB-2F-Books (OPAC Location) are not available until 31st Oct.
 - *For more information, please check the website Information on Renovation Work.

2. Materials of Kita-Aobayama Library

• Books: Only the books in the temporary library are available.

-OPAC Location: KITALIB-Temporary

*KITALIB-2F-Books (OPAC Location) are not available until 31st Oct.

-To check out books, bring them to the service desk.

• Journals: The library staff will make a photocopy. (Charges apply.)

-OPAC Location: KITALIB-3F-ForeignSerials, KITALIB-2F-ForeignSerials, KITALIB-1F-Stacks-ForeignSerials, KITALIB-1F-Stacks-JapaneseSerials, etc.

-To get a photocopy, search for an article via databases and make a request via "MyLibrary." Come to receive it after getting a notice from the library.

3. How to find materials

Tohoku University Library holds various types of materials: books, journals, newspapers, audiovisual materials, microfilms, etc. The library's holdings can be searched via OPAC (Online Public Access Catalog), which is accessible from the **Tohoku University Library's website**. In addition to searching by keywords, it shows new arrivals, related books, and virtual bookshelves. 4. Remote access to e-books and e-journals

Electronic materials are only accessible on campus. However, some of them are available for remote access. Check the website **How to Access Electronic Materials from Home**.

5. MyLibrary

"MyLibrary" is an online service, which enables you to:

- -check the status of your loan
- -renew your loan period
- -make a reservation for books on loan and books from other in-campus libraries
- -make a request for Interlibrary loan/photocopy (Charges apply.)
- -make a purchase request
- -make a reservation for study rooms and other facility
